- 3. It is the GLEMS committees' intentions to award a single scholarship of \$1,500. However, we reserve the right to award multiple, smaller scholarships and allocate the total amongst multiple qualified candidates.
- 4. Applications are due by May 1st, and the selected awardees will be announced and recognized at the annual GLEMS banquet, during each year's meter school (Attendance at the banquet is preferred, but not mandatory.).
- 5. Applications shall be submitted via email to the current GLEMS President.
- 6. Applicants must include a complete transcript of their high school performance. For applicants who have completed any post-secondary education, transcripts for those terms will be required, as well.
- 7. Applicants must include two letters of recommendation from applicable professional, business, or educational references.
- 8. Applicants must include a typed, written essay, detailing their background and motivation for seeking high education within the electric metering industry.
- 9. Applicants must have an accumulated GPA of 2.5 or higher.
